



**Proclamation of the City of Horseshoe Bay
Recognizing Brandon Lovelady
for Achieving the Rank of
Eagle Scout**

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America organization was founded in 1910, first awarded the rank of Eagle Scout in 1912, and serves as a vital force in the development of young boys and men to instill in them the qualities of honor, loyalty, courage, and service. The attainment of the rank of Eagle Scout is a major life accomplishment for a young man that is only achieved through his own initiative, hard work, and dedication, and not without the aid and support of his family, friends, troop members and scout leaders; and

WHEREAS, the brotherhood of Eagle Scouts is composed of many leaders of industry, science, government, and the arts with over two million having achieved the rank since its inception; and

WHEREAS, the City of Horseshoe Bay recognizes the valuable contributions of the Boy Scouts of America to our community and to our nation; and

WHEREAS, Brandon Lovelady, son of Robert and Laura Lovelady and a member of Boy Scout Troops 282 and 73, has been in Scouts for 12 years, earning the Arrow of Light in Cub Scouts and crossing over to Boy Scouts. Brandon has led his Troop as the Senior Patrol Leader for the past two years. He is a member of the Order of the Arrow and earned Brotherhood with the Tonkawa Lodge 99 in 2019. The Eagle Scout rank requires earning 21 merit badges and Brandon has earned 40 merit badges. Brandon completed 120 service hours leading his Eagle Scout Service Project, completing a Courtyard Renovation for the Epiphany Episcopal Church; and

WHEREAS, Brandon was confirmed an Eagle Scout after fulfilling all requirements and completed his Board of Review on September 22, 2020. His Court of Honor is being planned for the near future. On his 18th birthday, Brandon began the process to become an Assistant Scout Master with his Troop.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Mayor of the City of Horseshoe Bay, Texas on this 8th day of December 2020:

1. That the Mayor and City Council of the City of Horseshoe Bay recognize and congratulate Brandon Lovelady for this outstanding achievement.
