



## APPLICATION FOR THE HORSESHOE BAY CITIZENS ACADEMY

In 2016, the City of Horseshoe Bay initiated a Citizens Academy program, which seeks to educate citizens about how their local government works. The City hosts one Academy every spring and fall. Each Academy involves bringing together 15 citizens who will attend weekly sessions each Thursday afternoon for nine weeks. Each Thursday from 2:00 - 4:00 p.m., a different subject about local government will be covered by the City's leaders. For example, classes will cover a range of topics including City Council and Elections, Open Government, Fire, Police, Utilities, Finance, Code Enforcement, and Municipal Court. The final session is a graduation ceremony.

Attendance is limited to the first 15 individuals who submit a qualifying application. All others will be given first preference for the subsequent Citizens Academy. Applicants must be a City of Horseshoe Bay resident, with preference given to full-time residents. Emphasis will be given to creating a diverse class from as many neighborhoods as possible within Horseshoe Bay.
