City of Horseshoe Bay City Council Comments

October 17, 2023

The City of Horseshoe Bay City Council meeting was held on October 17, 2023, at 3 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Mayor Clinesmith called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance. The invocation was given by Pastor Malcolm McQueen with The Church at Horseshoe Bay, followed by pledges to the American flag and the State of Texas flag.

Proclamations

Mayor Clinesmith highlighted two proclamations, first declaring the Month of October 2023 as "Code Enforcement Officer Appreciation Month." This was presented by Development Services Director Sally McFeron, who recognized the Code Enforcement Officers Ray Garcia, Seleste Kos, and Alex Ocasio.

Second, the week of November 6-10, 2023, is "Municipal Court Week." This was presented by Finance Director Chris Thomas, recognizing Judge Kevin Maddison, Prosecutor Eddie Arredondo, Administrator Beth Kuentz, Court Clerk Ray Garcia, and Court Clerk Michelle Everly.

Announcements and Staff Recognition

City Manager Jeff Koska introduced the new Fire Chief, Doug Fowler, who retired from the City of Austin Fire Department as Assistant Fire Chief. While at the Austin Fire Department, he achieved the prestigious ISO 1 Certification for the city. Fowler has also worked as Fire Chief with the South Padre Island Fire Department and, most recently, with Hays County ESD#1 as Chief Administrator. He will be starting at Horseshoe Bay on Oct. 31.

Mayor Clinesmith introduced a new employee, Logan Stump, a utility plant operator who was absent.

Interim Chief Rhea Cooper presented Fireman Will Herron with his five-year service award.

Sally McFeron, Director of Development Services, shared the exciting news that the city achieved Platinum status, the highest level of a Scenic City designation. The city also received the prestigious "**Scenic City of the Year Award**" at the Dallas annual Texas Municipal League Conference in early October. The recognition attests to the City's natural beauty, community support, and cultural heritage of our exceptional community. Mayor Clinesmith thanked all employees who worked on the application, especially Susan White, who compiled all the information into the lengthy application.

Public Comment

Rick Overholt of HSB POA thanked the City's Utilities Department for work performed in the POA's Fuch Hollow Park, helping to remove a large Oak Tree that fell over into the spring waterway, creating a potential hazard for children who may fall into the tangle of limbs within the water. He contacted several tree companies for removal, but none could provide reasonable means to remove it from the water. He reached City Manager Jeff Koska, who requested Field Supervisor George Watson and his crew to see if they could assist with removing the tree, which was achieved this week. He thanked the crew members who removed the tree, Austin, Gerrad, Joseph, and Bryan, for their efficient work and courteous work ethic.

During Public Hearing Items:

Finance Director Chris Thomas presented preliminary end-of-year values, but both funds show more than 100 percent of total revenues collected and less than 100 percent of expenses used. The City continues to be financially responsible, and any excess funds carry over with funds balances and are used for payment towards capital projects, lowering bond issuance needs. Thomas said, "Overall, our departments are spending wisely and managing revenues effectively to keep day-to-day operations within budgets."
