

Join the City of Horseshoe Bay for the Annual Town Hall Meeting

All Horseshoe Bay residents are invited to attend the City's Annual Town Hall Meeting on Thursday, September 25 from 3 to 5 p.m. at Quail Point Lodge, located at 107 Twilight Lane.

The Town Hall meeting is a wonderful opportunity to hear directly from Mayor Elsie Thurman and City Manager Jeff Koska, who will share important updates about the city's growth, progress, and future plans.

Residents will learn more about the City's initiative to create a comprehensive community plan for balanced growth through 2040 and provide feedback on commercial and residential development, neighborhood safety, city character and connectivity, and many more plan initiatives. Several boards will be posted in the meeting room where residents can provide direct feedback on key focus areas by indicating their preferences for suggested community initiatives and goals. It's very important that residents participate in Town Hall, as the comprehensive plan will include adaptations based on citizen input from the meeting as well as future community-wide surveys.

Attendees will also receive an update on current capital projects, such as the construction of the new City Center, Fire Station #2 upgrade and a major water crosstown pipeline, as well as details about the upcoming 20th Anniversary Celebration scheduled for October 25.

After the presentations, residents may visit various stations set up around the room and speak directly with leaders from the Fire, Police, Utilities, Legislative Affairs, Finance, Human Resources, Public Works, Municipal Court, Communications, GIS, and Development Services departments. Each department will be on hand to provide updates, hand out information, and answer questions. Members of the City Council will also be present, ready to dive deeper into topics that matter to residents.
