

Horseshoe Bay 20th Anniversary Celebration Will Be an Event to Remember

Residents of Horseshoe Bay are eagerly anticipating the City's 20th Anniversary Celebration, scheduled for Saturday, October 25 from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. The celebration is being held on the grounds of the new Town Center, located at 9101 W. FM 2147, and you won't want to miss it!

Residents will convene on the Town Center grounds to enjoy the family-oriented festivities, which will feature musical entertainment from Triple Bogey, local vendors and food trucks, as well as prize giveaways, activities for kids, and a special presentation honoring the City's past and present leaders and volunteers.


Several area dignitaries plan to attend, including State Representative Wes Virdell, State Senator Pete Flores, Central Texas Deputy Regional Director for U.S. Senator John Cornyn Dylan Bricker, and Justice of the Peace Precinct 1 Sam Silver.

Event Parking

Residents will be able to park in the grassy field off of FM 2147 between Summit Rock Boulevard and Town Center. CARTS of Llano County has graciously provided a shuttle bus and driver to assist attendees in getting over to Town Center from the parking area.

Additionally, Mission Golf Cars of Marble Falls has donated two golf carts which will be operated by City employees to shuttle attendees between the parking area and the event.

The Horseshoe Bay Police Department will be directing traffic along 2147 to ensure our residents can traverse the area safely. The map below provides a visual of the parking areas. Some parking may be available in Escondido at the contractor entrance, though this area has been designated for event vendors and may have limited space left for attendees. Included among our vendors are three food trucks: Fat Boy Burgers, Cousin's Maine Lobster, and Marilu Dogs. Come ready to enjoy lunch during the event. There will even be dessert options from Hill Country Bakehouse!

Numerous wine and beer vendors will be onsite offering tastings and selling beverages: Bear King Brewing, Flat Creek Estate and Winery, Double Horn Brewery, Bronson and Ryder Brewing, 1914 Cowboy Bar, Jackson Family Wines, House of Cheese, and Spicewood Vineyards/Ron Yates. The City will also provide free bottles of water.

Bring the Kids and Grandkids!

The celebration will feature a kid's section where children can paint pumpkins, participate in mini putt-putt contests, and enjoy an educational scavenger hunt along the walking trail near Town Center. They might also enjoy the photo booth wall, where they can pose with celebratory props! City staff will assist families with taking commemorative photos.

Dogs Are Welcome

Residents may bring along their beloved pets so long as the pets are secured by a leash. If you don't already have a pet but are thinking of adopting one, visit the Hill Country Humane Society trailer! The Dog Wizard, specializing in behavioral and obedience training, has an awesome giveaway, including delicious dog treats. Feel free to take your pooch for a quick stroll on the walking trail and bring bags along to collect any pet waste.

Bring Forms of Payment and Sign Up to Win Prizes

Currently, the City has approximately 40 vendors who will either sell Texas-made goods and services or provide free items to attendees. Most vendors will be able to accept cash, checks, PayPal, or Venmo as forms of payment for the items they are selling. Come prepared to shop! Attendees will be able to peruse men and women's clothing, jewelry, home goods, books, outdoor gear, art, beauty supplies, health services and much more!
