APPLICATION FOR THE DOTTIE ANDERSON CITIZENS' ACADEMY: HSB 101 Spring 2020

In 2016 the City of Horseshoe Bay started a Citizens' Academy. In remembrance of long time Horseshoe Bay resident Dottie Anderson, a spring 2019 graduate, the Academy has been renamed the *Dottie Anderson Citizens' Academy*. There are nine sessions in HSB 101: eight classes with speakers with the ninth and final session being a graduation ceremony led by the Mayor and City Manager. The fall class will start February 6, 2020 and run for nine (9) total class sessions each Thursday afternoon ending April 2. Each Thursday from 2:00 - 4:00PM a different subject matter of local government will be covered by the City Manager and/or a department head. For example, classes will cover a range of topics from: Fire, Police, Utilities, Finance, Code Enforcement, and Municipal Court. The last session is a graduation ceremony.

Attendees are limited to the first 15 that submit a qualifying application. All others will be given first preference for the next Citizens' Academy. Applicants must be a City of Horseshoe Bay resident with preference given to full-time residents. If there are remaining seats available non-Horseshoe Bay residents may be considered. Emphasis will be given to create a diverse class from as many different neighborhoods within Horseshoe Bay.
