

Street Closures for Resurfacing

Alpha Paving Industries has been contracted by the City of Horseshoe Bay to resurface streets using an environmentally friendly pavement sealer. Our process involves a 3 coat application of a liquid asphalt mixture which is wet at first and must cure/dry before being driven on. This will be a 2 DAY process for EACH phase that will involve closing the street from 8:00AM to 5:00PM. This work will be done per the color coded schedule below.

Please DO NOT PARK on your street from 8AM ~ 5PM on your scheduled dates to prevent your car from being TOWED. Access IN + OUT of your driveway WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE. If you need to leave your home after 8AM, please move your car earlier to another street color that is not being resurfaced that day. Otherwise you may not be able to get out of your driveway due to the wet material.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Please do not drive on the fresh new surface until all cones have been removed
- The sealer WILL STAIN shoes, clothing, carpet, vehicles, sidewalks, and driveways
- Please keep pets/children indoors during work days.
- **Please turn off all sprinklers during your street's work days.** Water will damage the sealer. Also, please note that you may see slight tire marks on concrete driveways for about a month after work is done but that this is normal and will go away in 30 days.

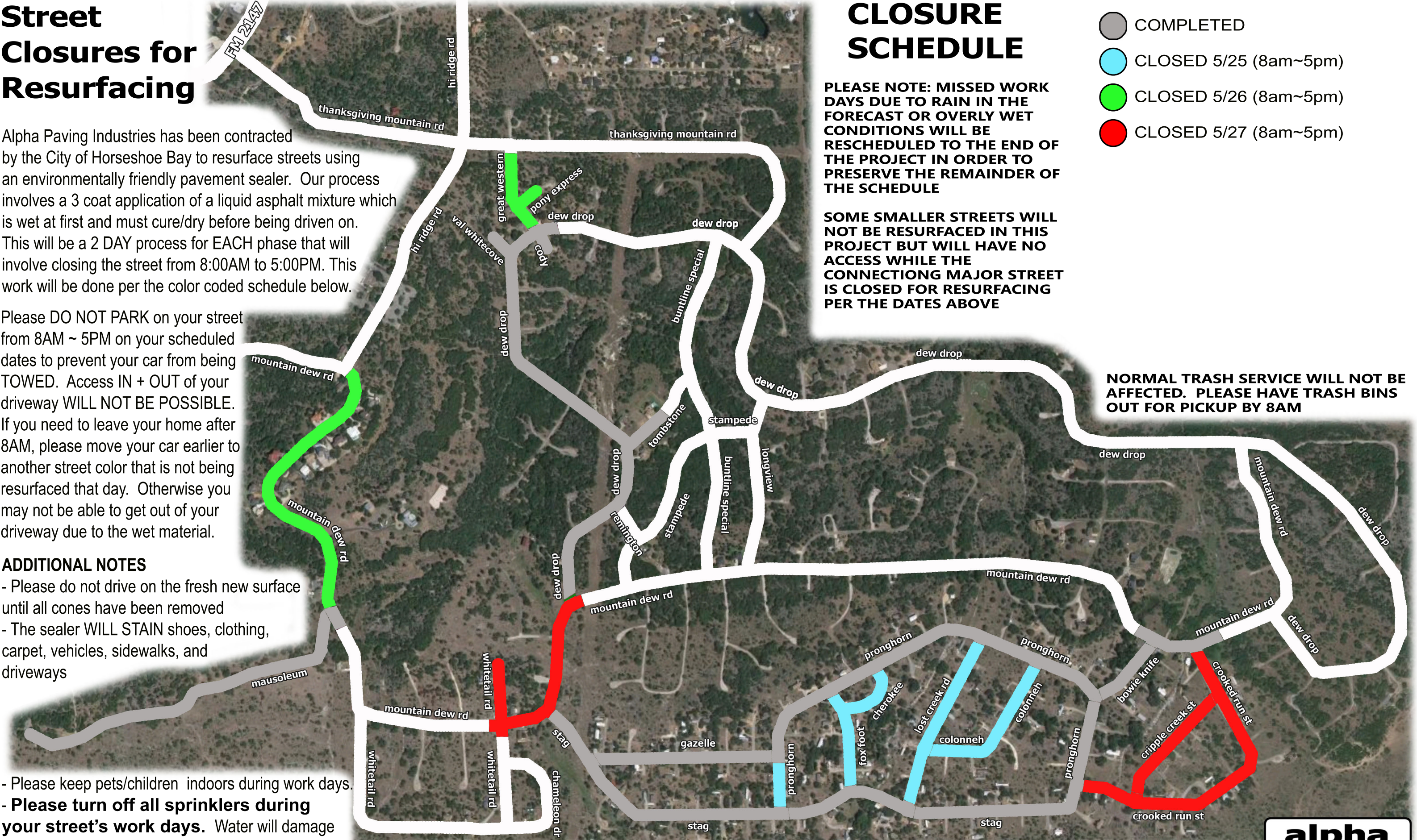
CLOSURE SCHEDULE
