



APPLICATION FOR THE CITIZENS' ACADEMY

In 2016 the City of Horseshoe Bay started a Citizens' Academy program, which seeks to educate citizens about how their local government works. Each Academy involves bringing together 15 citizens who will attend weekly sessions each Thursday afternoon for nine weeks. Each Thursday from 2:00 - 4:00PM a different subject matter of local government will be covered by the City's leaders. For example, classes will cover a range of topics from: City Council and Elections, Open Government, Fire, Elections, Police, Utilities, Finance, Code Enforcement, and Municipal Court. The last session is a graduation ceremony.

Attendees are limited to the first 15 who submit a qualifying application. All others will be given first preference for the next Citizens' Academy. Applicants must be a City of Horseshoe Bay resident with preference given to full-time residents. Emphasis will be given to create a diverse class from as many different neighborhoods within Horseshoe Bay.
