



**Proclamation of the City of Horseshoe Bay  
Declaring the week of May 7<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 as  
“Public Service Recognition Week” in Horseshoe Bay**

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Horseshoe Bay are served each day by public servants at the federal, state, county, and city levels. These unsung heroes do the work that keeps our nation and city working by ensuring clean water, public safety, integrity in elections and the legislative process, and proper management of public funds and resources; and

**WHEREAS**, each day, Horseshoe Bay’s public servants exhibit the highest standards of professional excellence, innovation, integrity, and stewardship, while providing outstanding service; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Horseshoe Bay recognizes our local public servants working in the following areas: City Manager’s Office, City Secretary’s Office, Development Services and Code Enforcement, Finance, Fire, Human Resources, Information Technology, Municipal Court, Police and Animal Control, Public Works, and Utilities; and

**WHEREAS**, without these public servants at every level, continuity would be impossible in a democracy that regularly changes its leaders and elected officials; and

**WHEREAS**, all citizens of the City of Horseshoe Bay are encouraged to recognize the accomplishments and contributions of your local public servants.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Mayor of the City of Horseshoe Bay, Texas:**

1. The week of May 7<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023 will hereafter be known as “Public Service Recognition Week”.
2. That the City Council calls upon all citizens to celebrate the public servants in their community, and their contributions, this week and throughout the year.
3. The City Secretary is hereby instructed to post this Proclamation on the city’s website for Public Display and enter this document into the permanent records of the City of Horseshoe Bay.
