



**Proclamation of the City of Horseshoe Bay  
Declaring the week of May 14<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023 as  
“National Police Week” in Horseshoe Bay**

**WHEREAS,** the Congress and President of the United States have designated May 15th as Peace Officers’ Memorial Day, and the week in which May 15th falls as National Police Week; and

**WHEREAS,** the members of the law enforcement agency of the City of Horseshoe Bay play an essential role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of the City of Horseshoe Bay; and

**WHEREAS,** it is important that all citizens know and understand the duties, responsibilities, hazards, and sacrifices of their law enforcement agency, and that members of our law enforcement agency recognize their duty to serve the people by safeguarding life and property, by protecting them against violence and disorder, and by protecting the innocent against deception and the weak against oppression; and

**WHEREAS,** the men and women of the law enforcement agency of the City of Horseshoe Bay provide an unceasingly vital public service.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Mayor of the City of Horseshoe Bay, Texas:**

1. The week of May 14<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023 will hereafter be known as “National Police Week”.
2. That the City Council encourages citizens of our community to join in commemorating law enforcement officers, past and present, who by their faithful and loyal devotion to their responsibilities, have rendered a dedicated service to their community and in so doing, have established for themselves an enviable and enduring reputation for preserving the rights and security of all citizens.
3. The City Secretary is hereby directed to post this Proclamation for Public Display and enter this document into the records of the City of Horseshoe Bay.
