Car Survival Kit Checklist

- ⊕ First aid kit and manual
- ⊕ Battery powered radio, flashlight and extra batteries
- ⊕ Jumper cables or a booster jump box for car battery
- ⊕ Fire extinguisher (a 5 lb., A-B-C extinguisher)
- ⊕ Bottled water
- ⊕ Nonperishable type foods such as granola bars, trail mix, etc.
- ⊕ Spare tire, jack, and lug wrench
- ⊕ Map
- ⊕ Escape tool within reach
- ⊕ Tow strap
- ⊕ Garbage bags
- ⊕ Spare cell phone charger
