



**Proclamation of the City of Horseshoe Bay
Declaring January 16, 2025
as “Mike Brittain and Francie Dix Day”**

- WHEREAS,** We are here today to express our love and appreciation to Mike Brittain and Francie Dix, for being visionaries for a successful business community and for showing all of us what love and respect for each other can produce; and
- WHEREAS,** Mike Brittain and Francie Dix organized the Horseshoe Bay Business Alliance in 2009 and wrote these words as their mission statement: “increase awareness of and promote the importance of the business community serving the residents of Horseshoe Bay.”; and
