URGENT: HB 5489 Threatens to Shift Development Costs to YOUR Tax Bill and Utility Rates**The Issue: Who Should Pay for Growth?**

When new developments are built in our community, significant infrastructure costs follow—water lines, sewer systems, road expansions, and more. Should these costs be paid by:

- **Current residents** through higher property taxes and utility rates? OR
- **Developers** who profit from these new projects?

For years, Texas cities have used **impact fees** to ensure developers pay their fair share of infrastructure costs. This fiscally responsible approach prevents existing taxpayers from subsidizing new growth.

HB 5489 would impose a five-year moratorium on impact fees until 2029.

This means:

- Developers pocket more profits
- YOU pay higher property taxes and water rates
- YOUR community loses local control over growth management

Immediate Action Required

The House Land and Resource Management Committee (which includes **your Representative Wes Virdell**) heard this bill on May 8th. It may reach the full House floor any day now. If passed by the House, it moves quickly to the Senate. Once this happens, stopping it becomes much more difficult.

What can you do?

Contact your legislators today to tell them to vote NO on **HB 5489**. Click on the Representative's name below to be taken to their "Contact Me" webpage.
